You can save tax dollars when you maximize your non-cash charitable deductions. The IRS allows you to deduct the Fair Market Value (FMV) — that is, the price the item would sell for in a thrift shop. The quality and condition, as well as age, must be taken into account. If you donated a large amount of goods, over \$500 worth, please call our office as the IRS may require a form 8283. Don't forget to ask for a receipt!

Below is a list of items that are typically sold at the local Salvation Army or Goodwill Stores, with a general range of values that these items would sell for. If you do not see the item you donated, please call several thrift shops and ask what they would sell the item for. The Salvation Army suggests using 25%-35% of what the items original FMV was when it was originally purchased. (IRS Section 170(b)).
